
Grieving the Death of a Loved One?

If you are 70 1/2 & Own an IRA, This Information is for you!

Did you know that you can make a contribution to a charity like St. John's Lutheran Church directly from your IRA to the Church and save paying some taxes? Qualified Charitable Donations automatically satisfy required minimum distributions for the year when the Qualified Charitable Donations is made. That's a real advantage for a charitably minded IRA owner who doesn't need required minimum distribution to live on. To make a contribution, contact your IRA trustee/ Agent to make a transfer from the IRA directly to St. John's Lutheran Church . Many trustees/ agents already have forms and procedures in place to make this transfer. It won't qualify if the check is made out to you. The Internal Revenue Service has said that a check from an IRA may be made payable to a charitable organization described in section 408(d)(8) and delivered by the IRA owner to the charitable organization.2 Be sure to obtain a letter of acknowledgment from the charity. Further questions, contact your IRA trustee/agent to see if your IRA qualifies for this.
