





THIS MONTH'S TRUTH: I Am Secure


TODAY'S MAIN IDEA: God Is Always Good



God showed His power when He raised Dorcas from the dead! Can you find all 10 of the items Dorcas made—2 of each item?




TAKE IT HOME






TODAY'S MAIN IDEA: God Can Always Be Trusted



ON YOUR OWN FIND THE DIFFERENCE


TAKE IT HOME
