Grief is an experience that most of us will be forced to deal with at one time or another. It is not something we choose and yet it is a part of life. Grief impacts us in a variety of ways: the death of a loved one, a life-altering medical diagnosis, death of a pet, the impact of life transitions – child going off to college or moving away, retirement, selling your home to move to a senior living community, the loss of a job... the list can go on and on.

This fall we will be offering an opportunity for Hosanna members and friends called *The Sacred Journey of Grief*. This is a time for us to gather and support one another as we journey through our own grief and loss. During our time together, we will experience scripture, acknowledge how grief impacts our bodies, minds *and* souls, learn some strategies that may help us as we make this journey, acknowledge some of the speed bumps in grief and those who choose to, will have opportunity to share parts of their story.

<u>Q/A -</u>


Is this for me? My spouse died 15 years ago, and I am still grieving? **Yes**, there is no timeline. You are welcome to come as you are without judgment.

School Kits for Lutheran World Relief -

*It would be appreciated if these items could be donated by Sunday, September 7th

Items Needed (per kit):

FOUR - 70-sheet notebooks of wide or college-ruled paper, approximately 8" x 10 ½"; no loose-leaf paper, solid color covers only

ONE -30-centimeter ruler, or a ruler with centimeters on one side and inches on the other

ONE - pair of blunt scissors (safety scissors with embedded steel blades work well)

FIVE - unsharpened #2 pencils with erasers; secure together with a rubber band

FIVE - black or blue ballpoint pens (no gel ink); secure together with a rubber band

ONE - box of 16 or 24 crayons

ONE - 2 1/2" eraser

**Please do not donate items with any religious symbols, messages or your group's name.

**Please do not donate any items decorated with a U.S. flag, patriotic or military symbols, or references to the armed forces, including camouflage.
