Capital Campaign Update By Rob Larsen



Hosanna Family,

It is hard to believe that we are already one year into our "Sowing Seeds of Faith for Today and Tomorrow" capital campaign. Due to the **outstanding generosity** of our members, we have received **more than \$304,000 towards our projected total of \$634,000 pledged!** On behalf of the Hosanna Council and the Capital Appeal leadership team, we would like to convey our heartfelt thanks.

Our properties team continues their hard work towards each of our Capital Campaign projects. They have been extremely busy gathering bids, meeting with contractors and evaluating the priority of each project.

Capital Campaign Projects Review:

- *Church Parking Lot Repair (Completed in June)
- * Sanctuary Window Repair
- * HVAC Update
- * Roof Repair
- * Memorial Garden Wall Repair (In progress)
- * Fire Suppression System Update
- * Carpet Replacement
- * Exterior Building Envelope Repair (Completed in 2024)

Work to repair the Memorial Garden wall should begin soon (some delays were experienced waiting for materials to become available). Brick repair and tuck pointing will be done, and the slanted brick walls will be capped with metal that matches the cross in the middle of the memorial garden wall. This will protect the wall from further damage.

Your generosity continues to make a tremendous difference in the future of our church.

LETTER FROM THE OFFICE OF THE BISHOP Greetings People of God at Hosanna Lutheran Church!

I write to you to share a bit of news with you.

One of your neighboring congregations, Peace Lutheran Church of Eyota, has been in a discernment process about their current pastoral needs and their financial capacity for pastoral support. Many of our smaller congregations in the SEMN Synod have been having similar discernment conversations.

The result of this discernment process for Peace Lutheran is that they have come to realize that they are only able to minimally compensate a pastor and therefore, they have prioritized the pastoral needs as preaching two times per month, teaching confirmation one time per month, and providing pastoral care in times of death or emergency.

The work of the SEMN Synod Office of the Bishop is to think creatively about how each congregation in our synod might be served by faithful leaders. We have done this through inviting congregations and pastors to enter what we are calling, a Holy Experiment. A Holy Experiment is a time when a pastor and a congregation enter an arrangement for a 'trial time' to see if it could be an arrangement that might work longer term.

Understanding that the pastoral needs of Peace Lutheran Church are minimal, we approached Pastor Strum with the possibility of trying a Holy Experiment with Peace Lutheran while continuing to serve in her full capacity at Hosanna Lutheran. Again, the pastoral needs at Peace Lutheran are for worship leadership two times each month so that the sacraments might be celebrated and there can be consistency in this, pastoral care in times of funerals and/or crisis, and the teaching of confirmation to two students one time each month. Pastor Strum and Reverend Barb Streed, Assistant to the Bishop, met with the leadership of Peace, Eyota to learn more about how this might work. Pastor Strum said she would pray about this opportunity and consider it, as well as bring the idea to the congregational council at Hosanna Lutheran.

After prayerful consideration, Pastor Strum and the congregational council of Hosanna Lutheran shared there was an openness to a Holy Experiment with Peace Lutheran with the following parameters:

Pastor Strum will:

- (1) provide worship leadership (preach and preside) at Sunday worship on two Sundays a month for three months [November 9 &16, December 7 & 21, and January 4 & 18].
- (2) provide confirmation instruction one time each month directly after worship on one of the Sundays she is at Peace preaching/presiding.
- (3) provide pastoral care in the event of a death in the congregation and/or in the event of an emergency.

LETTER FROM THE OFFICE OF THE BISHOP CONTINUED:

Peace Lutheran will:

- (1) compensate Pastor Strum directly for her service
- (2) utilize the same scripture texts as Hosanna Lutheran thus Pastor can preach the same sermon at both congregations
- (3) change their worship time to 11:00am to accommodate Pastor Strum and honor her time on Sunday mornings at Hosanna Lutheran.

Hosanna Lutheran will:

(1) graciously provide time for Pastor Strum to lead worship at Peace Lutheran on the named Sundays of each month which will require her to leave Hosanna Lutheran by 10:30am on those Sundays.

The Holy Experiment period will occur: November 2025, December 2025, January 2026. A review of the Holy Experiment will occur: January 22 with leadership from Peace Lutheran, Hosanna Lutheran, Pastor Strum, and a representative from the SEMN Synod Office of the Bishop.

It is with a heart full of thanksgiving to both Pastor Strum and the people of Hosanna Lutheran that we share this news with you.
