STEP 1 MEET

Are you new to Knollwood? We would love to feed you and get to know you. There's no obligation! Our next luncheon is on Sun March 20. Other ways of meeting with us are gathering on Sunday and staying for our after-service fellowship.

STEP 2 LEARN

INCOME TAX CLINIC

Knollwood will be hosting a Community Volunteer Income Tax Clinic Income Tax clinic again on Saturdays in March and April 2022.

The tax clinics are made available by Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) to help those who have low income and simple tax situations who meet criteria set by CRA.

We will need volunteers for: Tax Preparers and Greeters

In order to be a volunteer at the tax clinic you will need to be registered and trained.

Tax preparers will be trained on how to prepare tax returns and supervision will be provided to those preparing returns.
