Question 27:

Are all people, just as they were lost through Adam, saved through Christ?

Answer:

No, only those who are elected by God and united to Christ by faith. Nevertheless God in his mercy demonstrates common grace even to those who are not elect, by restraining the effects of sin and enabling works of culture for human well-being. *Romans* 5:17

STEP 1 MEET

Are you new to Knollwood? We would love to feed you and get to know you. There's no obligation! Our next luncheon is on Sun March 6. Other ways of meeting with us are gathering on Sunday and staying for our after-service fellowship.

STEP 2 LEARN

We desire that every person who is thinking of making Knollwood their church home would take a Membership Class. Learn more about what we believe, what the Bible says about church membership, and the process of becoming a member at Knollwood.

STEP 3 PARTNER

Discipleship Groups are groups of 4 to 6 members, intended to help believers grow through deeply studying Scripture and investing in prayer together.
