# FAMILY WORSHIP – FROM THE NEW CITY CATECHISM

*Question 28:* What happens after death to those not united to Christ by faith?

Answer: At the day of judgment they will receive the fearful but just sentence of condemnation pronounced against them. They will be cast out from the favorable presence of God, into hell, to be justly and grievously punished, forever.

John 3:16-18, 36

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God.... Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.

#### **STEP 1 MEET**

**Community Groups** are a place where you can say, "I belong"; where people can come with honesty; a place where you can make gospel friendship and grow as a disciple in Christ. Community Groups are for all church members regardless of the stage of life.

**Discipleship Groups** are groups of 4 to 6 members, intended to help believers grow through deeply studying Scripture and investing in prayer together.

#### Serving

We also ask that you find a place to use the gifts and talents God has given you to serve your church family. We have a number of areas (Children's Ministry, Music, Host Teams, Nursery), but if you can't find one that works for you, please talk to us.

There are two tables at the back of the auditorium where you can give as your worship. This Sunday, during Communion, we also ask for a benevolent offering (cash) which helps those in need within our church and in our community.
