"Mine Eyes Have Seen the Glory." I love this hymn because it reminds me of my elementary years. We sang this every Friday morning during the opening assembly.





PAVING THE WAY -

PARKING LOT RESURFACING

Property upkeep. Most of us know that over time there are repair projects that you can only put off for so long.

The parking of Gloria Dei is one of those projects. We have been patching,

those projects. We have been patching, painting new lines and it has come to the point that we need to resurface the lot.

We have a large surface area, and I am sure you all have noticed that there are certain spots that continue to deteriorate (areas shown in vellow).

Several members of the council have taken on the project to collect bids from 3 asphalt companies from the area that we have worked with and know personally. The final bid that has been accepted will be \$50-\$52,000 to resurface the front and side lots with a minor patch to the rear lot.

This is where all of you come in. We are looking to raise approximately 50% or \$25,000, with the remaining cost to come from our reserve funds. So far, we have raised \$16,843.64. We ask that each of you commit to praying and considering how you can give to this project.

There will be special offering envelopes as well as electronic giving options.

We will provide regular updates on our fundraising efforts in the weekly bulletins as well as within next month's newsletter.

GOOD SHEPHERD UPDATE FOR GLORIA DEI FAMILY

Dear Gloria Dei,

It is good to see you all again! So much has happened since I was in your beautiful church. I completed an internship and residency at KU Med, where I specialized in spiritual care in the oncology and trauma/ER departments, and served as one of two Catholic priests for over 1,000 patients and 14,000 staff members. My clericals became my scrubs, and I was blessed to encounter so many moments of God's comfort and peace, even in the midst of some of the most difficult situations in people's lives. I have grown used to being "Father" and see it as a sacred bond of trust and the greatest calling of my life, and I learned to grow into my role as a priest, pastor, and chaplain through years in the "trenches" and journeying with people through the joys and sorrows of life, and everything in between. I now have several hundred hospice patients and work with them and their family members as both a priest and a clinical counselor.

During this time, by the grace of God, my parish grew! We increased from 10 to 12 in 2020 and have been averaging 90 to 110 this year. By all accounts, we were doing everything a healthy parish should do, until our rental agreement almost doubled from \$6,000.00 almost overnight. Our community discerned that this financial increase was not sustainable and that resources would be better allocated elsewhere. Of course, finding a church building is a massive undertaking that takes time, prayer, and inventory. Following a period of evaluation, I reached out to Pastor Edd to explore a potential partnership with Gloria Dei, and he, along with the Church Council, graciously welcomed us.

My prayer is that the Good Shepherd Community will be more than just tenants for a time, but collaborators in Christ, and that we will be able to join alongside you in support of all that we have in common (a great deal) as co-laborers in the Vineyard. In a time when churches are struggling to stay open and remain viable, and the world seems content to build walls of division, I believe this presents an incredible opportunity for us to serve together, build bridges, and experience the Kingdom of God through Christ's love.

On behalf of my parish and staff, thank you for the warm welcome.




ORDINATION
