



Current Series - Authority

With 2 Samuel 23:1-7 and Mark 10:45 as our main texts we discuss how all authority is derived from God and is meant to be used selflessly for the flourishing of others. As we all will occupy roles in authority and under authority we must understand what God's Word says in order to steward our authority well.

April 1 - Authority: What and Why

Genesis 1, Psalm 8, and 2 Samuel 23 work together to help us see that authority is a moral license to exercise power for the good of others as authorized by God. We are to use authority to represent God, bring order, and bless others.

April 8 - Authority: Good and Bad

We see in Genesis 3 that the fall of man has corrupted all things, including the use of authority. We will walk through several examples of good and bad authority in the Bible and discuss how we can seek to use authority well.

April 15 - Authority Over and Under

Jesus is the perfect model of how to handle authority. He submitted to the will of the Father and used his authority to serve. We will look at Mark 10:45, John 13:12-17, and Philippians 2 to discuss how we can honor God when in or under authority.

April 22 - Authority Panel

We will be joined by a handful of members from our church who have served both in positions of authority and under authority. Students will have some questions for them as they share their experience and biblical wisdom.
