
WEEK 9 Sunday March 19

Discussion Question:

Apart from God, was there any way that the friends could have escaped the furnace? How does this help us understand our sin?



Jesus Connection:

God was with Shadrach,
Meshach, and
Abednego in the fire.
Only He could rescue
them. God rescues us too,
through His Son, Jesus.
Only Jesus can save us
from our sin. Jesus'
sacrifice on the cross
provided the way for us
to be rescued from sin
and have eternal life.

Discussion Question:

Has God promised to rescue us from every situation in life, like He rescued Daniel? What has He promised to rescue us from no matter what because of Jesus?

Jesus Connection:

bigger story. God
ultimately rescued us
from a much bigger
problem—sin and
death—through His
Son, Jesus.

Discussion Question:

How has God placed you in your neighborhood, school, or sports team to show people Jesus?



Jesus Connection: .

God's plan all along was to send the Messiah through Abraham's family. Haman's evil plan might have stopped God's plan, but God was in control. He was working out a plan to use Esther to rescue His people and make way for His Son, Jesus, to come into the world.

Discussion Question:

Did God forgive you a little or a lot? Why did He? Whom do you need to forgive?

Jesus Connection:

Nothing we do is enough to pay the debt we owe God and take away God's punishment for our sin.

Jesus came and died on the cross to pay for our sin and take the punishment we deserve. When we trust in Jesus, God forgives our sin completely. We can forgive others because God has greatly forgiven us.

Discussion Question:

What areas of your life do you need to remember that God is in control? How does remembering the evil done to Jesus and His victory give you hope?

God was in control over Haman's evil plan to destroy the Jews. Like Haman, Satan wants to destroy believers. He thought he had won when Jesus died on the cross, but God raised Jesus from the dead and defeated Satan once and for all.

keep His promise to give
us—His people—a home.
Jesus obeyed God
perfectly. He died on the
cross and rose again so we
can have a home with Him
forever.

JESUS AND ZACCHAEUS

Pages 185-187 Luke 19:1-10

Discussion Question:

Are there any people like Zacchaeus today? How can you help them know Jesus?

Jesus Connection:
Jesus came to seek and save the lost. He comes after us—sinners who do not deserve Him—and He rescues us from sin.
Jesus died on the cross for our sin, and He is glad when we repent and trust in Him.

JESUS REJECTED IN NAZARETH

Luke 4:14-30 Pages 182-184

Discussion Question:

Jesus' promise to help everyone, no matter where they were from, upset the people in Nazareth. What does this tell you about God's heart and man's heart?



Jesus Connection:
Hundreds of years before
Jesus was born, the
prophet Isaiah wrote
about God's plan to send
a Messiah. He would
bring good news and
redeem people who were
broken and hurting. Jesus
read Isaiah's words and
told everyone who was
listening that He is the
promised Messiah.

Discussion Question:

Jesus' family reminds us of God's faithfulness. How has God been faithful to you?

Jesus Connection:
Jesus came to earth as a baby in Bethlehem.
Jesus had earthly parents, Mary and Joseph, but His true
Father is God. Through Jesus, God kept His promises to Abraham and David. Jesus saves people from their sin and adopts them into God's family.

Discussion Question:

In what ways is it hard for you to trust and obey Jesus? Why do you?

from sin.

Discussion Question:

Jesus Connection:

Jesus offered the woman something no one else could give her—living water. Jesus wasn't talking about water that she could physically drink; Jesus was talking about the Holy Spirit who would satisfy her spiritual thirst. Jesus gives the Holy Spirit to those who come to Him by faith.

Discussion Question:
