

SERMON TITLE: Run YOUR Race: Unleash the Winner Within

KEY PASSAGE

Key Passage: Hebrew 12:1 -2

A Call to Endurance

- 1 Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off every encumbrance and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with endurance the race set out for us.
- 2 Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

INTRODUCTION

The movie "Pursuit of Happyness" based on a true story about a man named Christopher Gardner. Gardner has invested heavily in a device known as a "bone density scanner". He felt could do well by investing and selling these high technological devices. However, they do not sell well as they are a bit better than x-ray but at a much higher price. Gardner works to make ends meet, for his family in the middle of his struggles his wife leaves him and tries to take his son, he refuses to let him go with the mother having been abandoned by his own father at a young age. Fatherhood was important to him and therefore he was not going to abandon his son. He loses his apartment and is forced to live out in the streets with his son. Gardner continues to sell bone density scanners while simultaneously taking on an unpaid internship as a stockbroker, with very little education and marginal chances for winning the advancement to a paid position and is challenged with obstacles from every angle and having only six months training to prove himself and to sell his devices to stay float is based on a true story Regardless of his challenges, Chris never reveals his lowly circumstances to his co-workers, even going so far as to lend one of his bosses five dollars for a cab, a sum he can't afford. He also studies for and aces the stockbroker license exam. Chris ran and won his race.

SERMON POINTS

Point One: Run **YOUR** Race with Purpose

Luke 17:21 1 Cor. 9:26 Romans 8:28 Jer. 29:11

Point Three: STOP looking back when the race is ahead of YOU.

- 1. Looking back will stagnate your success and growth.
- 2. Looking back will cause you to remain in a state of defeat.
- 3. If you keep looking back it will allow the obstacles to overtake and block your view. There is a WINNER inside of you! Unleash HIM and DO NOT CLOG Him from flowing.

Phil. 3:13 Jer. 31:25 Heb. 10:35 Eccl. 9:11

BEYOND THE MESSAGE

- 1. Quitting is never an option when you are in Christ Jesus it is only an excuse. God has never called or seen us any way other than more than a conqueror. Quitter never win and a winner never quits. RUN your race!
- 2. The winner within you has given the greater power to endure and to preserve any obstacle thrown at you. Greater is He that is in you than he that is in this world.
- 3. Run Your race knowing that your purpose and goal will require endurance and faith.
- 4. Fixing your eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of your faith. Recognize who you are in Him.
- 5. "DO NOT look back" you cannot re -live what has already happened. Your future is in front of you. Embrace it with joy knowing that He will never leave you nor forsake you.
- 6. Jesus is our great reward at the end of the race. He is there waiting for YOU at the finish line.



SERMON POINTS

Point Two: Realign YOUR Focus and Faith

- 1. Run the race with persistent and determination.
- 2. Do Not be distracted by the things that <u>TRY</u> to weigh YOU down.
- 3. If you lose sight of the mark, you lose sight of the goal.
- 4. Do not run your race in vain but always be focused increasing your faith by staying in the Word of God daily.
