## How to Use This 7-Day Prayer & Fasting Guide

As we enter this sacred time of prayer and fasting, this guide is designed to help you focus, grow, and experience God more deeply. This is not just a routine—it is a spiritual journey where we are believing God together for healing, financial breakthrough, and the salvation of lives.

### Daily Structure

Each day of this guide is intentionally designed to lead you into God’s presence:

1. **Begin each day with the Lord’s Prayer.** This centers your heart, aligns your spirit, and reminds you of God’s will and His Kingdom purpose.
2. **Speak the Faith Declaration aloud.** Declarations build your faith and align your words with God’s promises. What you speak, you strengthen.
3. **Read the Devotional.** Allow the Word to speak to your heart. Reflect on how it applies to your life, your family, and others.
4. **Pray the Specific Prayer Focus.** Each day includes targeted prayer points focused on:
  - Healing for the sick
  - Financial victory and provision
  - Witnessing and reaching people for Jesus

### Fasting Guidelines

## Day 1: The Power of Intercession — Standing for Healing, Provision, and Souls

### Faith Declaration

### Devotional

This passage reminds us that we are not called to walk alone—we are called to stand together. In Luke 5, a paralyzed man could not get to Jesus on his own. But he had friends who refused to let his condition define his outcome.

They carried him. They lifted him. They broke through obstacles.

And when Jesus saw their faith, the man was healed.

This reveals a powerful truth: sometimes the breakthrough comes because someone else was willing to believe, pray, and stand in the gap.

# Day 2: Faith That Overcomes — Healing, Provision, and Purpose

## Narrative

In Mark 9, a desperate father brings his son to Jesus—a child bound, broken, and tormented. This is more than a story about deliverance; it is a picture of what happens when human limitations meet divine power.

The father had tried everything. The disciples had tried—and failed. But when Jesus steps in, everything changes.

This moment speaks to us today. There are people battling sickness in their bodies, struggling under financial pressure, and carrying burdens that seem impossible to break. Like that father, many are standing in the tension between faith and fear—believing but still wrestling.

Yet Jesus responds with power and compassion. The boy is healed. The situation is turned around. And what started as desperation becomes a testimony.

This reminds us of a powerful truth: God's power is not limited by our weakness—He responds to our faith.

And in this season of prayer and fasting, we are not just believing for ourselves; we are believing for others:

- Healing for the sick
- Breakthrough for those in financial struggle
- Salvation for those far from God

### 1) Faith Releases Healing Power

#### Prayer

#### Devotional

## Devotional

In this powerful moment, David stands between judgment and mercy. A plague is sweeping through the land, and lives are being affected. But God gives David an opportunity to respond—to intercede, to worship, and to shift the outcome.

Araunah offers David everything he needs for free. It was convenient. It was easy. It would have solved the problem quickly.

But David refuses.

Because David understood something powerful: what costs nothing carries no weight in the spirit. So he declares, “I will not offer to the Lord my God that which costs me nothing.”

And through that act of sacrificial worship, the plague stopped.

This is more than a story about giving. This is a revelation of how:

- Healing can be released

And that blessing flows into your family.

**Application:** Give with your family in mind. Believe God to break cycles of lack and establish generational provision and stewardship.

### 3) Giving Helps Reach Families for Jesus

Your giving is not just about your house—it is about God’s house.

Every seed you sow helps:

- Share the Gospel
- Strengthen families
- Reach homes that need Jesus

And as you give, you can stand on the promise: “Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household.”

**Application:** Pray for the salvation of your family. Pray for other families. Ask God to use your life and your giving to impact households for His Kingdom.

## Closing Exhortation

In this season of prayer and fasting, your giving is powerful.

It is:

- A seed for healing in your family
- A key for financial victory in your household
- A tool to reach families for Jesus

When you give God your first and your best, you are declaring: “God, not just me—but my whole family belongs to You.”

## Prayer

Father, in the name of Jesus, I come before You with a heart full of gratitude and worship. I acknowledge that everything I have comes from You.

Lord, today I honor You with my first and my best—not just for myself, but for my family. I place my household in Your hands.

Father, I declare healing over my family. Touch every person who is sick. Restore bodies, renew minds, and bring peace into every situation. Let Your healing power flow through my home.

Lord, I declare financial victory over my household. You are our Provider. Open doors, release resources, and establish stability and overflow. Break every cycle of lack and replace it with provision and increase.

Father, I lift up my family for salvation. Draw them closer to You. Save, restore, and transform every life. Let my home be a place where Your presence dwells and Your name is honored.

Lord, use my giving to impact other families. Let my seed help reach homes that need You. Let lives be changed, families restored, and generations impacted for Your glory.

Let my obedience release blessing. Let my worship shift atmospheres. Let my giving bring breakthrough.

Today, I declare: my family is covered, my family is healed, my family is provided for, and my family will serve the Lord.

In the mighty name of Jesus, Amen.

## Day 7: Miracle Faith — Believing for Healing, Provision, and Souls

### Faith Declaration

I declare that I walk by faith and not by sight. I believe that healing is already working in my body, financial victory is being released in my life, and God is using me to reach others for Jesus. I will testify of God's goodness. My family and I will experience restoration, provision, and divine encounters. This is my season of breakthrough, and I receive it by faith in Jesus' name. Amen.

### Scripture (NKJV)

- “Go your way; your son lives.” So the man believed the word that Jesus spoke to him, and he went his way. — **John 4:50**
- “For we walk by faith, not by sight.” — **2 Corinthians 5:7**
- “Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers.” — **3 John 1:2**

### Devotional

This story reminds us of a powerful truth: the miracle does not begin when you see it; it begins when you believe it.

A nobleman came to Jesus, desperate for healing for his son. His situation was urgent, painful, and beyond his control. Like many today, he was standing in a moment where he needed God to move.

But Jesus did not go with him—He gave him a Word: “Go your way; your son lives.”

And the man made a decision that changed everything—he believed the Word and walked away.

That is real faith.

In this season of prayer and fasting, God is calling us to that same level of belief:

- To believe for healing, even before symptoms change
- To believe for financial breakthrough, even before provision appears

- To believe that God will use us to reach others for Jesus, even before we see the results

Faith is not based on what you see—it is based on what God said.

### 1) Faith Releases Healing Before You See It

The nobleman believed before he saw the evidence, and healing was already taking place.

God's Word carries power. It does not need your confirmation—it only needs your agreement.

Healing begins the moment you believe.

**Application:** Speak healing over your life and others. Stand on God's Word. Believe that healing is already in motion.

### 2) Faith Positions You for Financial Victory

Faith is not just for physical healing—it is for every area of your life.

When you trust God's Word over your circumstances, you activate His provision.

Even when it doesn't look like it:

- God is working
- Doors are opening
- Resources are being released

**Application:** Declare God's promises over your finances. Trust Him as your source. Believe that provision is already on the way.

### 3) Faith Empowers You to Be a Witness

The nobleman didn't just receive a miracle—he received a testimony. And that testimony impacted others.

When God moves in your life:

- It strengthens your faith
- It encourages others
- It draws people to Jesus

Your healing, your breakthrough, your testimony—it is all connected to someone else's salvation.

**Application:** Share what God is doing in your life. Be bold. Let your testimony become a tool to reach others.

## Closing Exhortation

In this season of prayer and fasting, God is not asking you to figure it out—He is asking you to believe it.

Believe for:

- Healing in your body and your family
- Financial victory and provision
- Souls to be saved through your life

When you believe His Word, you position yourself to receive His promise.

## Prayer

Heavenly Father, I thank You today—not just for what I see, but for what I believe by faith is already happening.

Your Word is truth. Your Word is power. Your Word is life. And today, I choose to believe what You have said over what I feel and what I see.

Father, I declare healing over my body and over my family. Every sickness must go. Every condition must bow. I speak restoration, strength, and wholeness. You are Jehovah Rapha—the Lord who heals—and I receive Your healing power now.

Lord, I declare financial victory over my life. You desire that I prosper and be in health. I trust You as my Provider. Even when I don't see it, I believe You are working. Open doors, release resources, and establish me in provision and overflow.

Father, use my life as a testimony. Let my healing, my breakthrough, and my faith point others to You. Give me boldness to witness. Let me share Your goodness with those around me. Use my story to bring people to Jesus.

Lord, strengthen my faith. Help me to believe when it is hard. Help me to stand when I feel uncertain. Help me to trust Your Word above everything else.

I declare today: I believe. I receive. I will testify.

Healing is mine. Provision is mine. Purpose is mine.

In the mighty name of Jesus, Amen.
