SERMON TITLE: KEEP SHOWING UP: "THE ASSIGNMENT IS THE ASSIGNMENT"

KEY PASSAGE:

Galatians 6:9 KJV

⁹ And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season, we shall reap, if we faint not.

SERMON SUMMARY:

Galatians 6:9 reminds believers not to grow weary while doing good because faithful endurance produces a harvest in due season. This message emphasizes that God does not change the assignment because life becomes difficult. Believers are called to remain faithful, obedient, and committed even when the work feels heavy, progress is slow, and the outcome is unclear.

Like Noah, we must focus on obedience over outcomes. Like Nehemiah, we must continue building despite opposition and pressure. Like Elijah's servant, we must trust God even when we do not yet see the rain. Therefore, the central message is keep praying, keep sowing, keep serving, and keep building, because in due season, God will honor faithful endurance.

SERMON POINTS:

Point One: Place More Focus on the Assignment than the Outcome – Genesis 6:22

Point Two: Acknowledge the Weight of the Work – Matthew 11:28-29

Point Three: Rest in the Promise of Due Season – Habakkuk 2:3

CONCLUSION:

God never promised that the journey would be easy, but He did promise that faithfulness would produce a harvest in due season. Your responsibility is not to manufacture the blessing but to remain obedient, available, and committed to the work God has called you to do.

The assignment is still the assignment:

1. When you are tired,
2. When progress is slow,
3. When people misunderstand you, and
4. When the harvest has not yet appeared.

PROVOKING QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTIONS:

1. Have I become more focused on outcomes than obedience to God's assignment?
2. What assignment has God called me to remain faithful to even when progress feels slow?
3. Am I relying on my own strength or God's strength to carry the weight of my calling?
4. What distractions, disappointments, or opinions are tempting me to "come down" from the work God assigned me to do?
