“The most important thing about a person is what they believe about God.”

Are you confident that you are saved? God’s Word does not leave us wondering if we are saved, His Word gives us assurances.

God is HOLY.

Because God is absolutely holy and just, His standard to enter into His presence is absolute perfection. His character will not allow Him to be polluted by sin. He has given His commandments as the standard for human behavior. God's only just response to sin is to punish it and cast it out of His holy presence.

“But your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God, and your sins have hidden his face from you so that he does not hear.” Isaiah 59:2

“You therefore must be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect.” Matthew 5:48

Man is SINFUL.

God's Holy Word teaches us that we were all born sinners separated from God in need of salvation.

God PROVIDES.

Jesus brings one into a right relationship with God.
He alone removes the wrath of God.

Jesus Christ - Fully God and fully man came to the earth, lived a perfect life, took the punishment that we deserved, freely laid down His life on the cross in obedience to the Father, rose on the 3rd day and it is HIS WORK that saves. Without Christ there is no payment for sin.

Jesus alone SAVES.

Salvation is all of grace. Salvation is not a decision but a gracious gift of God.

“And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.” Acts 4:12

“But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.” Romans 5:8

“No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him. And I will raise him up on the last day.” John 6:44

“If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.” 1 John 1:8-10

“If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved. For the Scripture says, “Everyone who believes in him will not be put to shame.” For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same Lord is Lord of all, bestowing his riches on all who call on him. For “everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.” Romans 10:9-13

“The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel. Mark 1:15 Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household.” Acts 16:31

“Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes has eternal life.” John 6:47
