



1 Corinthians 13:1-3

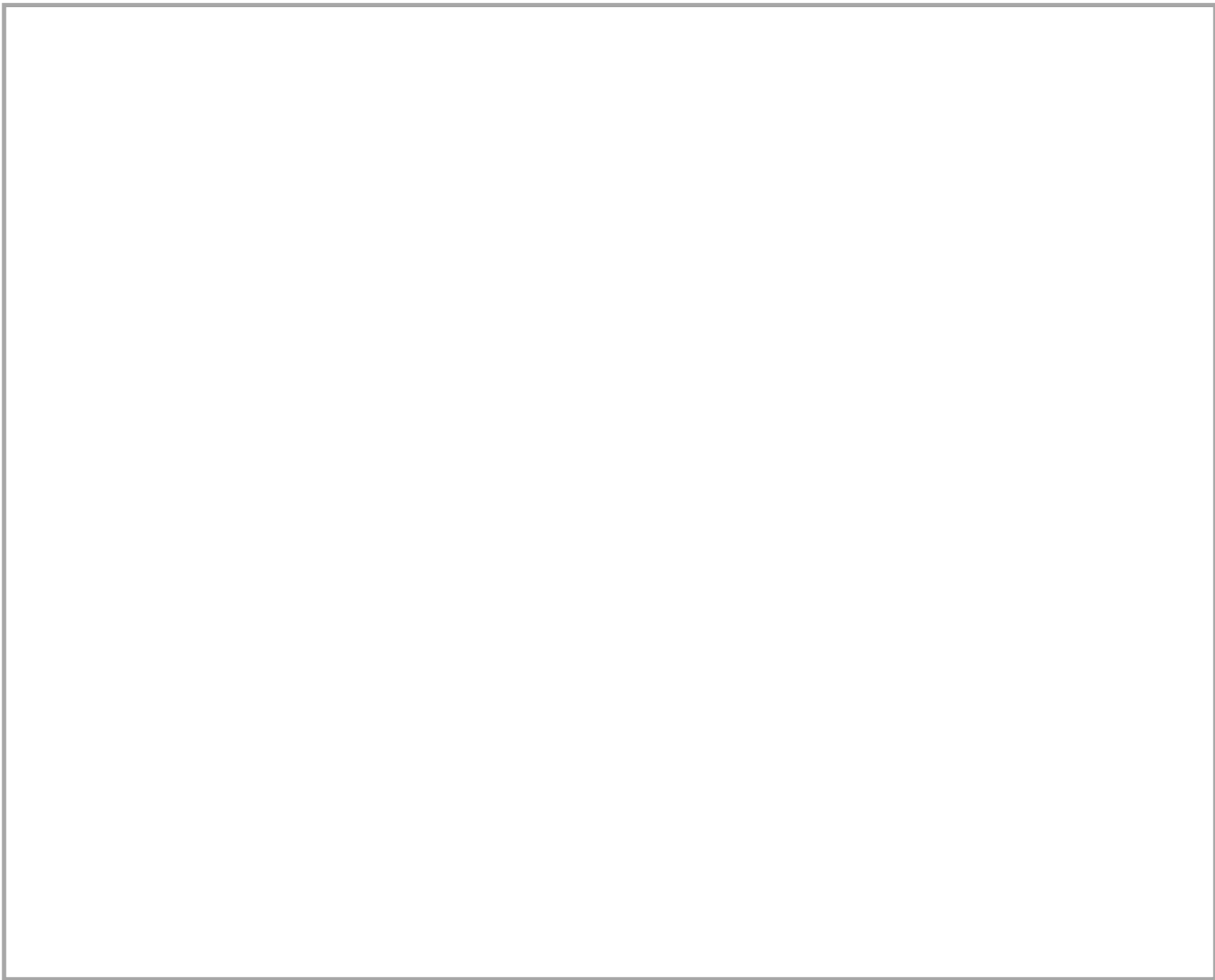

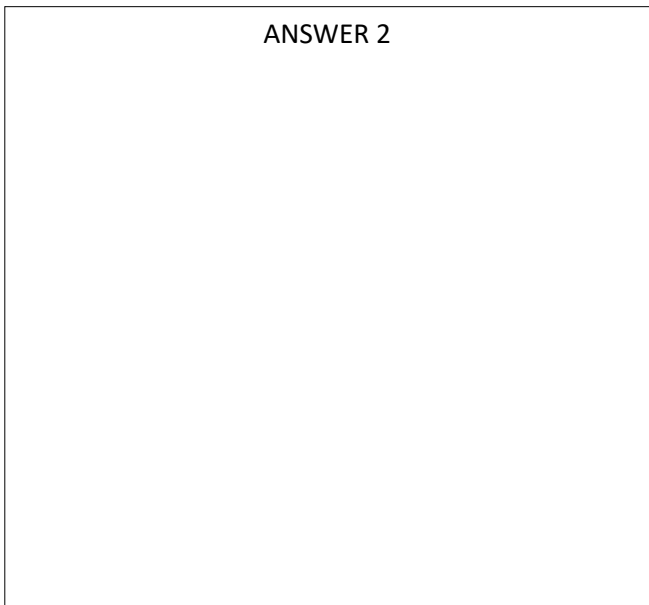
How does what you say or want to say change if we remember that we are to speak with love?
