ELDER RECOMMENDATION INSTRUCTIONS

Overview of the Office of Elder for The Journey Church

The body of elders at the Journey Church is a group of spiritually gifted and mature Christian men who have been called by God to serve together under the guidance of the Holy Spirit. They will lead our Church in carrying out its vision and pursuing an effective ministry by shepherding, modeling, teaching, and managing. The group will include partners who have met and completed all requirements of the elder process.

Basic Requirements

- ☐ He upholds the truths in 1 Timothy 3:1-11 and Titus 1:5-9.
- ☐ He is not a new Christian but has been saved for a while (~ 8-10 years).
- ☐ He has been a partner of Journey Church for at least 3-5 years.
- ☐ He has been baptized by believer's baptism.

Elder Recommendation Process

Please prayerfully consider the Biblical qualifications as you recommend men to serve our congregation as an elder. To recommend a man, first you must receive their consent. Then fill out this Elder Recommendation Form. This form can either be given directly to the Lead Pastor or to any current elder. All recommendations will be reviewed and prayerfully considered by the body of elders.

Each person recommended as an elder will be asked to complete the Elder Application Form. This form will be made available once the Elder Recommendation Form has been submitted and reviewed. The completion of the Elder Application and its corresponding requirements (found in the Elder Application) are necessary before any man may take the office of elder.

Biblical Qualifications for Elder

The passages 1 Timothy 3:1-11 and Titus 1:5-9 form the basis for Elder qualification and selection.

The saying is trustworthy: If anyone aspires to the office of overseer, he desires a noble task. Therefore an overseer must be above reproach, the husband of one wife, sober-minded, self-controlled, respectable, hospitable, able to teach, not a drunkard, not violent but gentle, not quarrelsome, not a lover of money. He must manage his own household well, with all dignity keeping his children submissive, for if someone does not know how to manage his own household, how will he care for God's church? He must not be a recent convert, or he may become puffed up with conceit and fall into the condemnation of the devil. Moreover, he must be well thought of by outsiders, so that he may not fall into disgrace, into a snare of the devil. Deacons likewise must be dignified, not double-tongued, not addicted to too much wine, not greedy for dishonest gain. They must hold the mystery of the faith with a clear conscience. And let them also be tested first; then let them serve as deacons if they prove themselves blameless. Their wives likewise must be dignified, not slanderers, but sober-minded, faithful in all things. - 1 Timothy 3:1-11

This is why I left you in Crete, so that you might put what remained into order, and appoint elders in every town as I directed you— if anyone is above reproach, the husband of one wife, and his children are believers and not open to the charge of debauchery or insubordination. For an overseer, as God's steward, must be above reproach. He must not be arrogant or quick-tempered or a drunkard or violent or greedy

for gain, but hospitable, a lover of good, self-controlled, upright, holy, and disciplined. He must hold firm to the trustworthy word as taught, so that he may be able to give instruction in sound doctrine and also to rebuke those who contradict it. – Titus 1:5-9
