

Team Update from Win:

This month we're back working together at our Team base, but still many covid cases in our area. We heard that high schools may open in November. No news yet about primary schools. Our hope is that during December we can do Christmas outreaches in schools, or in nearby communities. We are praying for God to lead us in this.

Some Progress: While working from home, we managed to get 2 new cartoon stories started for our new evangelistic booklet, and both the storyboards are done for these. Now we can start on the cartoon pictures. This month we're also working on ideas for more cartoon stories and other articles.

Re School Outreaches: We heard that only those who are fully vaccinated will be allowed to visit schools. Jeen and Mew were vaccinated. I registered, but it's not a good system here, so still can't get it. We all want to be able to go to schools again to bring Jesus to Thai children so are praying for God's help.

My prayer is for God to lead our Team and guide us so our work can develop in God's way and we can do it as well as we possibly can. When God opens our country again, and especially the schools, we want to be ready with media and cartoon booklets and new lessons.

Updates from Others in the Team:

Nut: Please, pray as we make video content, and for a new video project. We posted Episode 1 of this on Facebook - introducing young people to Jesus' story. All who are interested get our 2nd video clip, which teaches more about Jesus. We're now thinking and planning for a 3rd clip for all who are contacting us. We do need God's wisdom.

Mew: Please pray for me about serving God. We continue to write new lessons. Please pray with us for God to give us good ideas and His wisdom, so our lessons can speak to this new generation of Thai young people.

Aey: While schools are closed we can't send our evangelistic cartoon books to school libraries. But young people are contacting us in other ways and we're sending lessons to many.

Bai: For our work, may God give us wisdom as we think about the best video content we should use that will help Thai children to learn and know the love of God.

Jean: I thank God for each child and teen doing our lessons. And the students from the dormitories. Some of these students have finished at school and left their dormitory, but still write to us, Many really open up their hearts and talk about their problems. They say they have no else they can talk to about these things, but say they really trust us.

Manao: May God give His wisdom and His love as we think about videos and about stories and ideas for a new cartoon book. We ask for wisdom because all these different types of creative work we are doing are new for many of us.

Kanchana: I thank God for His protection for me, our Team and our families. Please pray for each one of us to grow in God's ways. Some Team members are feeling tired in mind and heart. We know this is a spiritual battle, and partly it is because we can't get to schools. As we pray together, may God refresh and strengthen each one of us in Him.

Please pray also for our country. Protests against the Government continue daily. I am praying God will protect people in these protests. Please pray for God to move in our country, and open the hearts of Thai people to Himself so there can be real change here.

From Win - Last month, my father died, and that was a hard time for me and my family. But we thank God so much that my father had become a Christian. My mother and brother had turned to Jesus, but my father resisted for years. Until God spoke to Him miraculously one night. Here is a picture which is special to me of my father after he was baptised several years ago. Thank you for praying for our family.



From Pai - I thank God for saving my life. Last month I had Covid-19. It was very bad, but now God has healed me. That was a big experience in my life and I learned more about God and about trusting Him.

From Kanchana - My mother became a Christian 2 years ago, but there are no other Christians in her village. I used to take groups of teens from FahSai Club to see her and tell their testimonies. And we taught the Bible, but we had to stop going after covid. Then I found large print books of the Bible for her. She reads these all the time. Recently she decided she wanted to throw out all the idols and images in her home. This is a big step as she had trusted in these things most of her life, but now wants to show she is free of all them and instead she is trusting in Jesus.

Others in our family and village wouldn't understand so we knew we had to do it in the right way. Two weeks ago Win and I went to her home. Together we took everything off the idol shelves, and got rid of them in the correct way. We prayed with my mother and for her as we did this. I am so excited and thankful as I see God doing this miracle.

Some recent letters from students in the dormitories:

Jantra: *I thank Jesus for sacrificing His life and help me know He loves me with unconditional love. I'm asking God to help my family and help me get a job. Thailand has problems a lot. May God protect us and give us hope. And I thank God for my sister. She is changing and she has a chance to know God's love.*

Tanapan: *God is my Father. He always listens when no one else can and can fix things that are not right. I am not good at listening to others and often criticize. I keep thinking about alcohol, smoking, drugs. I want to stop. God is love. I need His love to fill me. Please pray for me.*

Kritsanachai: *God is my Father and my saviour. He helps me from bad things and to stop doing son as I pray. I call Him Papa and want to say that I trust you God, My Father.*

Nathaphon: *I have sinned in my thinking and I want to stop. I don't want to think about it, and I try and pray, but at times I still do it. I really need help from God.*

Kiattisak: *The Prodigal story son feels like my story. I have been lost and made mistakes. My family is sad about that but they are forgiving me. This story shows me God always forgives me and always gives me a chance to return to Him.*
