## Powerful Picture....

One of the most powerful pictures that I’ve ever seen is the picture above that was taken this past weekend at our February 24-26 Youth Impact Conference. This is a group of students who were not kneeling to ask Christ into their life; but rather, they were kneeling, asking God to have them provide a life-giving “snorkel” to those around them. Our speaker Runks shared a powerful story of a friend that had gone boating. While they were swimming, the friend’s sister got her foot caught on the bottom of the lake that they were boating in and the friend frantically jumped from the the boat to try to save her sister’s life. The friend’s sister’s face was only 12 inches from the surface of the water and the friend did everything that she could to bring the breath of life to her sister that was drowning, unable to do so. If the friend would have had a snorkel, the sister would have been able to breath.

I ask you to continue to be in prayer for this group of students that they recognize that they can offer the life-giving “snorkel” to a friend that does not know who Christ is. They are a missionary to a fallen friend. Pray that God empowers them and gives them the courage to share the Hope of the Gospel with a friend that does not know who Jesus is. I appreciate each one of you so much for making this ministry possible, for allowing us to be on the front line, and share the Hope of the Gospel with the world that does not know who Jesus is.
