

September 2022

"We want spiritual growth!" These were the words I heard as I read through West Lake's congregational profile, prior to accepting the call as your pastor. According to you, you wanted to dive deep into your spirituality; you wanted to be given opportunities to grow in your faith and your understanding of God. West Lake wanted depth, and that excited me. I too desire deep meaningful conversations that lead to growth. I too long for my understanding of God to mature and develop into something more like Christ's. I believe that is part of what God saw when he brought us together – a deep desire for spiritual growth.

Lucky for us, we have been growing together through worship, through Bible studies, through prayer group, and through service. However, if you are someone who has felt that the well has been a bit shallow for you, if you feel like you haven't really had that spiritual growth you've desired, then this month of September is for you. In the thirty days of September, we will have thirteen days that offer an opportunity for Bible Study, five days that offer opportunities to go to God in communal prayer, and four days of Sunday morning worship. That is a grand total of twenty-two opportunities for growth to happen.

Of the thirteen days of Bible study, our Fishing for Women team will be leading five of them as they take the women of our congregation on a discovery of how Jesus treated women. I've listened to a bit of what this study covers, and I am excited to see the growth these women will have. Regarding the other eight days of Bible study, I will be leading them. Four days will be Brown Bag Bible Study where we wrestle through the challenging word of God together to try and uncover just what the truth of that passage is. The other four days will be focused on how we inherit eternal life – the answer is much different than what your Sunday School teacher taught you. I invite you to be present, not at all of these, but at some. Ensure that your hunger for spiritual growth is satisfied.

Scholarship Committee

About 10 years ago West Lake Christian Church needed a new minister. Kelly Caldwell was hired as a Transitional Minister but Kelly lacked the educational requirements needed to be licensed by the Christian Church, Disciples of Christ. Kelly enrolled in a course of classes that would qualify him for that recognition. Several members of the congregation wanted to support Kelly in this endeavor and contributed funds to the church to help Kelly offset that cost.

After Kelly's death, Rev. Chance, Kelly's wife Nancy and their son Danny Boteler discussed how to best use the contributions received by West Lake Christian Church in memory of Kelly. They were all in agreement to establish the Caldwell Memorial Scholarship. A scholarship committee, at WLCC, has been set up to determine the guidelines and an application for awarding a scholarship. It is our intent that awards can be made to anyone who wants to further their education after high school graduation or GED. The scholarship can be used for trade school, two or four year degree or graduate level school in any field. In order to make this an ongoing fund there needs to be a substantial amount to invest so that only the interest is being used to make awards. While there is a nice start to the fund it is a long way from making it sustainable. The committee will be holding fund raisers and asking for congregational contributions. On Sunday mornings contributions can be put in envelopes and designated for the Caldwell Memorial Scholarship. If you contribute electronically you can go on the app and designate an amount to go to the fund. A Ham and Bean dinner is being planned for this fall.

This scholarship has the potential to change lives. You all have the chance to be part of that change through your contribution to this fund!
