1. Read Luke 16:11. Our natural condition is to be tempted by passion (what we desire), position (status), and possession (material wealth). Discuss the importance of developing a godly character.

2. What does it mean to give or to be generous? Why is giving so important? In what ways, besides money, can we give to others?

3. Read 2 Corinthians 9:13. We benefit when we are generous and when we receive the generosity of others. Share with your group a time when you were blessed by giving or by receiving a gift?

4. How do you define materialism? Why is generosity the 'cure' for materialism?

5. Read 1 Timothy 6:17-19. Why does the state of our heart matter when we give of ourselves to others and how is the blessing returned to us?

6. Read 2 Corinthians 9:11. God also promises that when we give, our resources will be multiplied. How is appropriating this promise a vital test of our faith?
