

# Heroes of Faith ~8 How to trust God with my fears. 1 Samuel 17:1-50

'Isn't it obvious that God deliberately chose men and women that the culture overlooks and exploits and abuses, chose these 'nobodies' to expose the hollow pretensions of the 'somebodies'? That makes it quite clear that none of you can get by with blowing your own horn before God.' 1 Corinthians 1:26-29 MSG

'A champion named Goliath, who was from Gath, came out of the Philistine camp. He was over nine feet tall. He had a bronze helmet on his head and wore a coat of scale armour of bronze weighing five thousand shekels; on his legs he wore bronze greaves, and a bronze javelin was slung on his back. His spear shaft was like a weaver's rod, and its iron point weighed six hundred shekels. His shield-bearer went ahead of him.' 1 Samuel 17:4-7 NIV

'Goliath stood and shouted to the ranks of Israel, "Why do you come out and line up for battle? Am I not a Philistine, and are you not the servants of Saul? Choose a man and have him come down to me. If he is able to fight and kill me, we will become your subjects; but if I overcome him and kill him, you will become our subjects and serve us." 'Goliath stood and shouted across to the Israelites, "Do you need a whole army to settle this? Choose someone to fight for you, and I will represent the Philistines. We will settle this dispute in single combat! If your man is able to kill me, then we will be your slaves. But if I kill him, you will be our slaves! I defy the armies of Israel! Send me a man who will fight with me!" When Saul and the Israelites heard this, they were terrified and deeply shaken.'

'I have done this to both lions and bears, and I'll do it to this pagan Philistine, too, for he has defied the armies of the living God! The LORD who saved me from the claws of the lion and the bear will save me from this Philistine!' 1 Samuel 17:36 NLT

'Then Saul dressed David in his own tunic. He put a coat of armour on him and a bronze helmet on his head. David fastened on his sword over the tunic and tried walking around, because he was not used to them. "I cannot go in these," he said to Saul, "because I am not used to them." So he took them off. Then he took his staff in his hand, chose five smooth stones from the stream, put them in the pouch of his shepherd's bag and, with his sling in his hand, approached the Philistine.' 1 Samuel 17:38-40 NIV

'David shouted in reply, "You come to me with sword, spear, and javelin, but I come to you in the name of the LORD Almighty—the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied. Today the LORD will conquer you, and I will kill you and cut off your head. And then I will give

the dead bodies of your men to the birds and wild animals, and the whole world will know that there is a God in Israel! And everyone will know that the LORD does not need weapons to rescue his people. It is his battle, not ours. The LORD will give you to us!"'

- 1. Read 1 Samuel 17:14-15. Sometimes in life we face a delay. Share with the group what God taught you while you waited on him?
  - How can remembering how God helped you in the past assist you for the future?
- 2. Read 1 Samuel 17:23-24. Goliath berated the Israelite army and they were afraid. What negative voices do we often listen to that can make us afraid?
  - How can surrounding yourself with people filled with faith help conquer our fears?
  - What changes can we make to build a stronger faith in God?
- 3. Read 1 Samuel 17:38-40. If God has called you to fulfil a role, then he doesn't expect you to doubt him and wait to take the first step. He wants you to trust him. Often people will try to persuade you to do it their way instead of the way that God has prepared you to move ahead. David didn't use the armour Saul had used but instead chose the tools he understood and was skilled in using. How can you discern that the tools, (talents) you have are the right ones?
  - How can you trust God and relax in fulfilling what God has called you to do?
- 4. David was viewed as a long shot because he had no experience, was just a shepherd and Goliath had an arsenal of weapons. Yet, David changed the rules of the fight because he had a heart filled with the Lord, 1 Samuel 30:6. List some ways to encourage yourself in the Lord in order to enhance the faith condition of your heart.
  - How can we develop a "yes, God" attitude, no matter what he asks of you?
