NLT: And the Lord—who is the Spirit—makes us more and more like him as we are changed into his glorious image.


VOICE: So we are being transformed, *metamorphosed*, into His same image from one radiance of glory to another, just as the Spirit of the Lord accomplishes it.

John 15:4-5 NIV




