### **Family Support**

Beyond the classroom, we are exploring new and creative ways to walk alongside the vulnerable families of our students. This means offering parent support services that strengthen homes and build stronger futures.



### **Beacon of Hope**

ICEP gives hope to vulnerable families through quality education for their children and a Haitian-led school staff who serve as daily role models; showing students the opportunities education can unlock.



### **Nutritional Support**

All students and staff receive a hot and nutritious mid-day meal. For many, this is the only nutritious meal they will eat that day. This program is generously fully funded by one of our Corporate Partners.

### School Funding & How You Can Get Involved

At ICEP, we believe that when families contribute, they're more deeply invested in their child's education. That's why we ask families to pay a small tuition fee.
