

LAUNCH PAD

Our church is located on the space coast of Florida. In our backyards we see rockets regularly being launched. People have gone to the moon from the launch pads in our county. We want our church to be a launch pad for sending people out on the mission God has for them. One church cannot reach the world by itself, and that is why Launch Pad exists. Launch Pad is to equip leaders to make disciples here and everywhere for the glory of God. Our goal through Launch Pad is all about sending. We call it "Launch 10X." Over the next 10 years we aim to launch:

- 10 new churches
- 100 individuals into vocational ministry or mid to long-term missionary service
- 1.000 leaders
- 10,000 disciples

We want to equip everyone in the church for this goal. The way we will do this is through helping people DISCOVER who God has made them to be, TRAINING them to be equipped for the task, and LAUNCHING them out on mission with King Jesus.

This is not something we can do on our own, this is a God-sized goal. We would just ask you to pray about how God might be calling you to live on mission for King Jesus.
