- Recruit, form, and lead volunteer and contract musicians in both English and Spanish
- Build teams and delegate responsibilities effectively
- Coordinate and maintain schedules for choirs, cantors, accompanists, and instrumentalists
- Manage and supervise the music ministry budget
- Maintain and organize the parish music library and related resources

- Demonstrate a deep appreciation for the role of sacred music in worship
- Exhibit strong pastoral leadership, initiative, and organizational/executive skills

- Set and implement short- and long-term goals for the music ministry
- Show creativity and a commitment to ongoing musical, liturgical, and professional development
