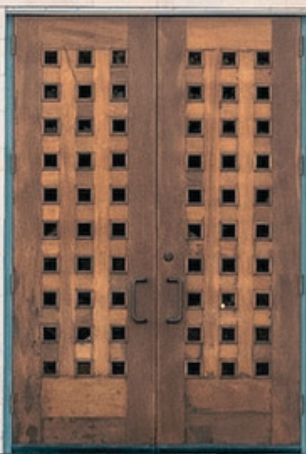

Saving Israeli Mothers and Their Babies

Every month, Beth Messiah sends financial support to a host of Messianic organizations, one of which is Be'ad Chaim. Sadly, the abortion rate in Israel is about 1 in 5 pregnancies. In an effort to prevent the deaths of these unborn babies, Be'ad Chaim was founded in 1988. This ministry helps mothers in Israel who choose to keep rather than abort their babies by providing necessities such as diapers, baby formula, and clothes for a whole year. They also provide counsel and education to mothers who have undergone abortions or lost homes.

INTERNATIONAL SHOAH REMEMBRANCE DAY



Holocaust Remembrance is coming up on January 27. For those of Jewish decent, one can never forget the heinous acts of a dictator and a compliant people. It is as equally important for the people of the Nations to never allow the atrocities of such acts to happen ever again.

In the Torah, in Exodus 20:13, the commandment says "Do not murder". Genocide is an act of murder and is not from Adonai.

On November 1, 2005, during the 42nd plenary session, the UN designated resolution 60/7 - International Shoah Remembrance Day. The day marks the liberation of Auschwitz-Birkenau on January 27, 1945, in honor of the victims of the Shoah. Some remember this day by lighting a Yharzeit candle.

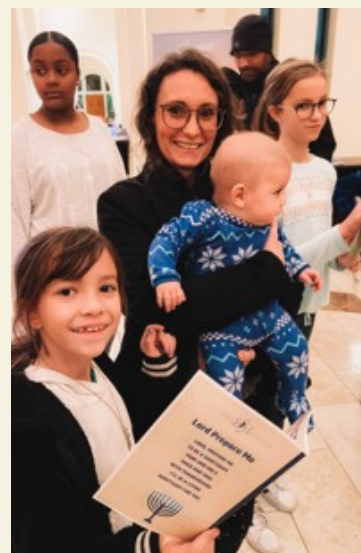
