ISRAEL IS STILL ISRAEL, THE APPLE OF HIS EYE

As I write this article, we have crossed the 700-day mark since Hamas invaded Israel, murdered and butchered over 1200 innocent people and took hostage over 250 people. I have purposely crossed out the name of this terrorist organization because Israel was instructed to blot out the memory of Amalek (Ex. 17:14; Deut. 25:19). I believe this terrorist organization is that spirit of Amalek. At the time of this writing there are 47 hostages still held in Gaza, and 20 to 21 are believed to still be alive. This is terrible. This is a nightmare. This is unacceptable. This makes me angry. All of this is horrible, and we as Messianic believers grieve with the families of the deceased hostages and stand with them in solidarity to get their family members returned to them with dignity. And we pray those still alive will be brought home to live the rest of their lives in Israel.

But what has caused me to name this article as I did is to refute the diabolical scheme of the enemy to blot out the people of Israel; not just physically, but in the hearts and minds of the world as G-d's chosen people. I cannot believe it, but out of the mouths of some of our politicians, bloggers, media personnel, and (sadly) some pastors spews forth the completely unbiblical idea that the people of Israel today are not the ancient people of Israel that G-d made a covenant with through Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. What? Without naming names, you can guess who I am talking about, can't you? At least one big conservative name who says he is a born-again Christian and who used to be on the big conservative news channel in prime time argued with one of our Texas senators about this very thing. The issue was whether Israel is to be supported by believers. The argument was that today's Jewish people are not the same Jewish people that we find in the Bible, and the Ancient Near East. Well... hogwash! Am I allowed to say that word as a Messianic leader?

Our Messianic rabbi friend Jonathan Cahn called this person out on this topic recently. His argument was that the people of modern Israel would have had to have their ancestors do some serious genetic gymnastics to NOT be the same people we find in the Tanakh and in the Brit Chadashah. His best point was that the genetic testing of today proves beyond a shadow of a doubt that modern Jewish Israelis are descendants of the Ancient Middle Eastern Semitic people group known as the Jewish people. But the enemy is deceptive, and he will use any tactic to deceive, divide, and destroy.

But why? Why is there so much hatred and antisemitism toward such a small people group as the Jewish people? Because the enemy that lost at the Tree of Sacrifice does not give up trying to destroy G-d's plan for Israel. Paul wrote this to the Colossians: "After disarming the principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in the cross" (Colossians 2:15, TLV). The enemy wanted to destroy the plan of Yeshua to be the Messiah, but he failed. What was to be a public humiliation of Yeshua at the Tree of Sacrifice became a tide-turning, script-flipping moment when our King of Kings rose from the dead to overcame death and the grave!

But what does that have to do with Israel being Israel today? Glad you asked! Since the enemy has been defeated and his days are numbered, he must try to destroy the covenant people of G-d, the Jewish people. John wrote this imagery down in Revelation chapter 12. At the beginning of the chapter, a woman representing Israel gives birth to a child. This child is Yeshua. The enemy tries to devour the child but fails, and the woman (Israel) is protected by G-d. I want to pick up in verse 13 of chapter 12:

13 Now when the dragon saw that he had been thrown to the earth, he stalked the woman who had given birth to the male child. 14 But the woman was given two wings of the great eagle, so that she might fly away from the presence of the serpent into the wilderness, to the place where she is taken care of—for a time, times, and half a time. 15 And from out of his mouth, the serpent spewed water like a river after the woman, in order to sweep her away with a flood. 16 But the earth came to the aid of the woman. The earth opened its mouth and swallowed the river that the dragon had spewed from his mouth. 17 So the dragon became enraged at the woman and went off to make war with the rest of her offspring—those who keep the commandments of G-d and hold to the testimony of Yeshua (Revelation 12:13–17, TLV).

Verse 17 says it all. The enemy is enraged with Israel and continues to make war with the rest of her offspring. Friends, the Messianic remnant and those believers who stand with Israel are his number one target. The enemy is using Islamists to attempt to carry out this destruction, and he is slandering the Jewish people using anyone who will be a mouthpiece of antisemitism and Jew-hatred. Why? Because he has lost, and his goal now is to desecrate, destroy, and wipe out the Apple of G-d's eye. If he can do that, how can they later turn, repent and receive Yeshua as their Messiah?

So, what are we to do? Pray like never before for the salvation and restoration of Israel and the Jewish people. Stand with Israel! Join us Saturday night, October 18th at Congregation Beth Messiah for a Stand with Israel conference night featuring Paul Wilbur. Continue to speak the truth in love to your Christian friends and continue to stand with Israel as a people! You do not have to like everything their government does. Instead, we are to stand with G-d's people, Israel. I love this last blessing from the Amidah:

"Grant peace, goodness, blessing, grace, kindness, and compassion upon us and upon all your people, Israel. Bless us, our Father, all of us as one, with the light of Your face, for with the light of Your face, You gave to us, ADONAI our G-d, the Torah of light and love of kindness, righteousness, blessing, compassion, life and peace. And may it be good in Your eyes to bless Your people Israel at every time and at every hour with Your peace. Blessed are You, L-rd, Who blesses the people of Israel with peace. May He who makes peace in His heavenly realm make peace for us, and for all Israel. And let us say, Amen."
