

EXCELLENT LOVE

I was a freshman in college who had never been on a date. My standards were high and the very small pool of boys at my private high school (there were 10 in my graduating class) had not presented any possible prospects.

After graduation, I began my college years at Houston Baptist, as it was then called. There was a banquet at my old high school, and I was invited to give a speech. However, I needed a date. So I asked a boy from college that I was “kind of” friends with. He was a senior and a leader of several organizations including a singing group. He was a gentleman, he was funny, and he seemed to love Yeshua with all his heart. As an 18-year-old those were my only 3 requirements to date someone. I asked him to go. He said he would check his calendar in case he had a gig on Valentine’s weekend, but he would get back with me. Two weeks went by. He didn’t get back with me. With some embarrassment I finally had to remind him about going with me on Feb. 12th to this banquet. He said he was sorry, he forgot to let me know, but yes, he could go with me. I thought, “Pity date. This might be tough.” But I said great, it’s a date.

He picked me up in a nice suit, I greeted him in my borrowed green dress, and we were off. We talked through the entire program, posed for a picture, and then headed to a restaurant for dessert. He offered to buy me a Dr. Pepper. Now, I was from a ministry family. We only ate out when there was a buy one get one free offer, and we never, ever drank anything but water. So when he offered to buy me a Dr. Pepper, I hardly knew what to say. I accepted the generous offer and slowly sipped this rare treat in between sweet conversation as we talked till the restaurant closed. He took me home; I invited him to come in and we talked till 3 AM. Ten months later we were engaged and a year after that we were married. That was 35 years ago. It is my excellent love story.

It has been 38 years since that first date on Feb. 12th. I remember thinking that night - this is the person I have been waiting for. I thought this is crazy, wonderful love. When we married, I thought, “I am so in love with Mr. Incredible, and I can’t possibly love him any more than I do today!”

But what I have discovered is that while that was wonderful love, it does not compare to the excellent love we share 36 years later. This love has been fought for, doubted, glued together, sometimes hanging by a thread, thriving, flying high, down for the count, and resurrected. We have both endeavored to grow, to forgive, to bless, and to believe the best. It has been a process.

But you know what is not a process? God’s excellent love for you. He loves you completely yesterday, today and forever. You can’t do anything to earn it. God’s love isn’t based on you; it is simply placed on you. His excellent love believes in you, restores hope, and never fails. Excellent love is patient and kind, it does not envy or boast, it is not proud. His excellent love keeps no record of wrongs. He does not delight in evil but rejoices in the truth. This love always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.

John and I are both praying that you will come to know that love, if you have not. And if you have, that you will continue to grow more deeply each day in the knowledge that you are loved by the Author of the most excellent love story ever written, and know that He wrote it for you.

Shabbat-G-d's day of rest

What is Shabbat

Shabbat, the Hebrew word for the Sabbath, is the seventh day of the week. It is the day on which the Torah states that G-d rested from His work of creation. The name "Shabbat" derives from the Hebrew word *lishbot*, which means to rest. Since the seventh day was the day that G-d rested from working, and on which the Jewish people were commanded to rest from working, it is known as "the day of rest." It is not just that G-d finished His work and rested on the seventh day; the Torah explains that G-d blessed the seventh day and sanctified it. The seventh day therefore became G-d's special day.


Shabbat School


