IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT THE LORD'S SUPPER

The Bible teaches that along with the bread and wine of Holy Communion we also receive the true body and blood of our Savior. Jesus' own words, "this is my body" and "this is my blood for the forgiveness of sins" reveal His Real Presence in the sacrament (Luke 22, I Cor. 10:15-16). The Bible also teaches (1 Cor. 11:23-32) the Lord's Supper, properly received brings great blessings, but improperly received without understanding can actually incur God's judgment. If you are a baptized Christian who has been instructed in the Biblical teaching of communion, please feel free to commune today. If you have any questions, please first speak to a pastor.

As you come forward, gluten free wafers are available by request, as well as individual cup choice of wine or lighter colored non-alcoholic grape juice (located in the center of the trays). Common cup is also offered during Traditional Praise services at the altar only. The Lord's Supper is celebrated in Traditional Praise on the first, third, and fifth weekends of the month; and in Modern Praise on the second and fourth weekends of the month.

Biography and Personal Word Pastor Jon Trinklein

Pastor Jon's life-long passion has been and will continue to be in his retirement the making of as many disciple-making disciples possible!

He is a graduate of Concordia Universities, Ann Arbor, Michigan (1975) and Chicago, Illinois (1977) and Concordia Seminary (1981), St. Louis, Missouri. He has served as an inner city pastor in Inglewood, California, a church planter in Little Rock, Arkansas, the vice president of the Mid-South District of the LCMS, Discipleship/Executive/Missions Pastor of King of Kings, Omaha, Nebraska, served on a City Transformation Roundtable of Omaha/Council Bluffs (a city-wide leadership constellation of church, business, government, education and media leaders), Lead Pastor at Shepherd's Gate Lutheran Church, Shelby Township, Michigan and as a mission leader taking teams to Russia, Africa, Israel and China. He



participated in the development of Lutheran High Schools in Inglewood and Little Rock. He mentored and helped launch a Sudanese Lutheran Church in Omaha and ordained two pastors at Shepherd's Gate.

He served as the chairman of the northern Macomb County National Day of Prayer Gathering and as Coordinator of Macomb Transformed for Christ which is a coalition of about thirty churches in Macomb County, Michigan. Together, Pastor Jon and his wife Sue led prayer seminars in over 50 churches across our nation as well as England and China. And for the last five years he has had the joy of serving in his home church here at St. John Lutheran Church and School, Rochester, Michigan as a part time Pastor of Mission Mobilization and most recently Pastor of Discipleship.

Pastor Jon and Sue have been married 46 years and have two grown, married children: Jordan and his wife Melissa, and Tessa and her husband, Leon. They are delighted to be Papa and Nana to their beautiful grandchildren, Natalie, Jacqueline and Emily Richards and Dylan and Quinn Trinklein.

"To my family, know how much I love you and thank God for you. I pray you will always know the grace and love of our Savior Jesus. I am deeply thankful for the loving support Sue has given to me for all the years of marriage and ministry. 
