- 1. Walk In Love
- 2. Walk As Children
- 3. Walk With Caution

Walk In Love: Do You Know The Love Of God? Walk In It

and walk in love, just as Christ also loved [a]you and gave Himself up for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God [b]as a fragrant aroma. (v.2)

Walk As Children: What Pleases The Lord?

Be imitators of God(v.1) Learn what is pleasing to the Lord. (v.10) Walk as children of Light (v.8,13-14)

Best use of our time Understand the Lord's will Be filled with the Holy Spirit Live in Community

Life Group Thoughts & Discussion

Getting Past Good Enough We all want to be good, but sometimes we're not. What do we do when we fall short?

Discussion Questions:

- 1. When you think of a really good person, who comes to mind? What is it about them that makes you say that?
- 2. Read Psalm 15 aloud, where David list some of the characteristics of someone who would be considered a good person, full of integrity.
- What does it mean to speak truth "from the heart?"
- Talk about a time when you kept an oath "even when it hurt"—or when you didn't and wish you had?
- What are some other ways we can "lend money without interest?"
- 3. When we're beyond our ability to truly do good, our only choice is to surrender.

We do that by: Admitting our inability, Confessing our unwillingness, Inviting the Holy Spirit to help

Which one of those steps is most difficult for you? Why?

4. Are you in a situation where someone has wronged you? When it comes to that situation, what would "goodness" look like for you? How do you need God's help? Have you been faithful to fulfill it?

Has God placed people around you to watch over? How can you remain faithful to walk with God as you walk with them in the days, months, and years ahead?
