



Week 2 – The Bible Shows Me the Way!

Arrival and Guided Play (5-10 minutes)

This week's focus is learning *The Bible shows me the way* and *God's Word lights my path* (Psalm 119:105). Introduce this concept simply and playfully using toys and activities. This flexible time helps everyone get settled into the classroom and ready for the day's lesson!

Toy/Activity Ideas:

- **Flashlights or Glow Sticks** – Let's shine our lights! The Bible helps us see the right way to go, just like a flashlight in the dark.
- **Toy Cars and Road Tape** – Let's drive our cars on the road! The Bible helps guide us on the right path.
- **Building Blocks and Tunnels** – Let's build a tunnel or a path! God's Word shows us the way to go.
- **Path Puzzle or Floor Tiles** – Let's make a path across the room! The Bible helps our feet know where to step.
- **Stuffed Animals** – Let's pretend our animal friends are walking on a path. We can help them find their way with our flashlight—just like the Bible helps us!

After the children have arrived, gather everyone together.

TEACHER: Let's clean up our toys and come sit in a circle to play a game together!

Group Game (5 minutes)

Follow the Light

Supplies Needed:

- Flashlight (or small glow stick if preferred)

Setup:

- Dim the lights slightly or close curtains to make the flashlight visible.
- Clear a safe open space for walking.

TEACHER: Let's play a game called Follow the Light! (Turn on the flashlight and shine it on the floor.) When the light moves, we'll follow it! (Move the light slowly in front of the group.) Stay right behind the light—don't go too fast! (Pause and let the kids giggle as they follow.)

You did it! The light showed us the way. God's Word is like a light that shows us the right way to go. When we listen to the Bible, it helps us follow Jesus. Say it with me:
God's Word shows me the way!

Bible Story (10 minutes)

God's Word Lights my path (Psalm 119:105)

Main Idea: The Bible shows me the way

Summary: The Bible guides my steps every day

SUPPLIES:

- Printed picture of a dark path with a little light ahead
 - Printed picture of a child holding a lantern or flashlight to see the path
 - Printed picture of the same child walking safely along the lit path
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TEACHER: (Hold up your Bible.) This is the Bible—God's special book! It tells us what is true and helps us know the right way to go.

(Show the class the picture of a dark path with a little light ahead.)

Look! It's a dark path. When it's dark, it's hard to see where to step. (Pretend to take small steps and look around.) We might trip or get lost if we can't see!

(Show the class the picture of a child holding a lantern or flashlight.)

Now we have a light! (Pretend to shine a light.) Do you see the path? The light helps us see where to go. God's Word is like this light—it shows us the right way to walk and helps us follow Jesus.

(Show the class the picture of the child walking safely along the lit path.)

Now the child can walk safely! When we listen to what the Bible says, it helps us

make good choices and stay close to Jesus. Say this with me: God's Word shows me the way!

PRAYER TIME:

Let's talk to God together. You can repeat after me.



Craft (10 minutes)

Bible Bookmark

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Cardstock strips (2×6 inches, pre-cut)
- Crayons or markers
- Stickers (optional)
- Hole punch (optional)
- Yarn or ribbon for tassel (optional)



TEACHER: Today we're making a Bible bookmark! (Hold up an example.) A bookmark helps us remember where we stopped reading. The Bible shows us the right way to go, so this bookmark can remind us to read God's Word every day.

(Hand out cardstock strips.) Use your crayons to color your bookmark any way you like! You can add stickers or draw a Bible, a heart, or a light. (Walk around encouraging kids as they color.) If you'd like, we can add a tassel at the top. (Punch a hole and help thread yarn through for each child.)

Your bookmark looks wonderful! When you see it, remember—God's Word shows you the way!


