This boy is someone special in my heart. His name is Eduardo, he's 11 years old, and he's been at the Zacapa Children's Home for four years. He's had a lot of behavioral problems and episodes of violence, which led to him being referred to a psychiatrist. He's currently on medication prescribed by the psychiatrist, but he still has violent episodes. I've carried a heavy burden in my heart for him, and that's why I've been near him very often. When he's with me, I pray for him and show him the love of Jesus. He tells me that when he's near us, he experiences great peace and feels a lot of love. I firmly believe it's the peace and love of God that touches his heart. So far, he hasn't had any visits from family members; he's practically been forgotten by them. Eduardo asks me to lead the prayer at the beginning of any activity with his group, and he's learned several Bible verses. I thank God for giving us the opportunity to serve the lambs of Jesus.
