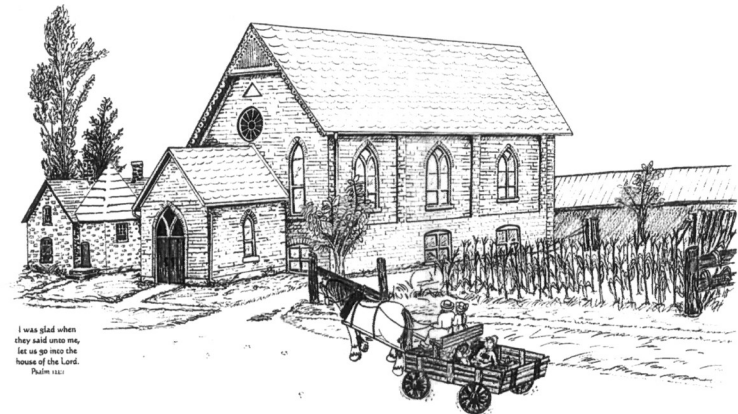
Teachers are missionaries too. Ben Gavey's Prayer Requests:
