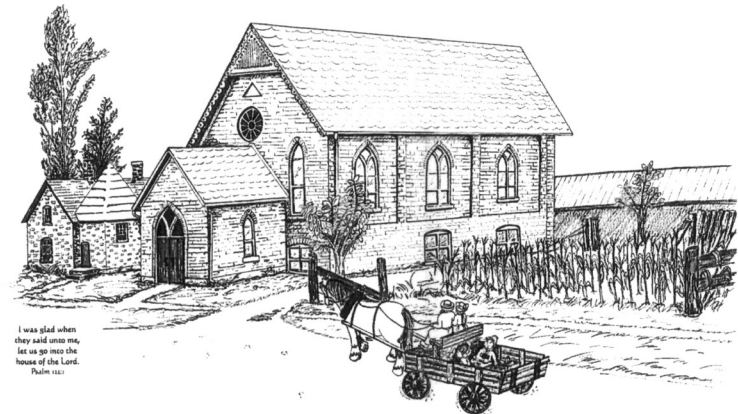
Prayers for the Persecuted Church in China
