
PLACER COUNTY 2025 POINT-IN-TIME COUNT & SURVEY



Each year, communities across the country conduct a Point-in-Time (PIT) Count to measure the number of individuals experiencing homelessness on a single night in January. While HUD requires annual counts of sheltered homelessness and biennial counts of unsheltered homelessness, Placer County Continuum of Care conducts comprehensive counts of both sheltered and unsheltered populations every year.

The 2025 PIT Count reflects where people stayed the night of January 28, with surveys conducted in the days immediately following. The surveys accounted for 711 people experiencing homelessness in order to profile their experience and characteristics.


TOTAL POPULATION LONGITUDINAL TREND




2025 SHELTERED/UNSHELTERED POPULATION



2025 UNSHELTERED INDIVIDUALS BY AGE





2025 POPULATION BY REGION








CHRONIC HOMELESSNESS

An individual with one or more disabling conditions, or a family with a head of household with a disabling condition, who:

- Has been continuously homeless for one year or more and/or;
- Has experienced four or more episodes of homelessness within the past three years.

VETERANS

Persons who have served on active duty in the Armd Forces of the United States. This does not include inactive military reserves or the National Guard unless the person was called up to active

UNACCOMPANIED YOUTH **& YOUNG ADULTS**

Youth under the age of 18 and young adults from the ages of 18 to 24 years old (TAY) who are experiencing homelessness and living without a parent or legal guardian.

FAMILIES

A household with at least one adult member (persons 18 or older) and at least one minor child member.
