COMMUNION SERVICE TODAY

As we share in the celebration of the Lord's Supper today, those wishing to receive communion will be coming forward, down the center aisle, to receive the elements from the table. Please pick up a cup of bread and a cup of juice and return to your seat (by way of the side aisle) to partake of the elements. For those who moving to the front is not as easy to do, please remain in your seats. Communion Servers will be stationed in the side aisles and will come and serve you.

WORLD COMMUNION SUNDAY

The first Sunday in October is designated as World Communion Sunday, which celebrates our oneness in Christ with all our brothers and sisters around the world. The Holy Spirit connects us as a body of Christ through time and space, through cultures and nationalities. Every person who comes to the table, proclaiming Jesus as Savior, is connected by the Holy Spirit at this moment. There are no barriers due to language, culture, race – the Holy Spirit removes all barriers.

On World Communion Sunday, as we reaffirm the promises of our baptism and recommit ourselves to serve God and others in our world, we also will remember that our church family is part of the global Church. This Sunday in worship, we will hear praises and prayers in other languages, and have the Lord's Prayer written and available in French, Spanish, Russian, and German for our time of prayer. We continue to await the time when we are all gathered around the feast in heaven – every nation, tribe, and tongue.

GIVING

The Christian life is an offering of one's self to God. One of the ways we respond to Christ's call to discipleship is by returning some of the financial provision that God has provided to us.
