Sermon Notes: February 1, 2026

Mark 10:17-27; 1 Timothy 6:6-10

GENEROUS—The Freedom of Enough

Main Points

- Our relationship to money and material things exposes what we really believe about life and eternity.
- The love of money is a trap that ensnares and destroys those who fall into it.
- Generosity is the key to avoiding being ensnared and destroyed by greed.

Other Scripture Referenced

- “Jesus said again, “Very truly I tell you, I am the gate for the sheep. All who have come before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep have not listened to them. I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved. They will come in and go out, and find pasture. The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.” - **John 10:7-10**
- Keep falsehood and lies far from me; give me neither poverty nor riches, but give me only my daily bread. Otherwise, I may have too much and disown you and say, ‘Who is the LORD?’ Or I may become poor and steal, and so dishonor the name of my God. - **Proverbs 30:8-9**
- “I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. I can do all this through him who gives me strength.” - **Philippians 4:12-13**

Application

- The next time you receive “extra,” take time to ask God how he wants you to use it.
