

GENEROUS—Investing in the Kingdom of Heaven

Main Points

- Investing well begins by valuing the right things.
- Jesus' parable illustrates the main idea, "*life does not consist in an abundance of possessions.*"
- The rich man was in error because he assumed that the abundance was intended for him, and so he invested foolishly.
- The discipline of generosity will protect us from investing foolishly and lead us to value Jesus and his kingdom instead.
