"Serve" John 13:1-5, 12-17

Key Verse: "Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet. ¹⁵ I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you." (John 13:14-15)

How we discover our mission (how God wants us to serve)

1. Think Little

Jesus knew that the Father had put all things under his power, and that he had come from God and was returning to God; ⁴ so he got up from the meal, took off his outer clothing, and wrapped a towel around his waist. ⁵ After that, he poured water into a basin and began to wash his disciples' feet, drying them with the towel that was wrapped around him. (John 13:3-5)

"Then the King will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father; take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world. ³⁵ For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, ³⁶ I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me.' (Matthew 25:34-36)

Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: ⁶ Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped (Philippians 2:5-6)

2. Think Local

but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. (Philippians 2:7)

3. Think Laser

And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death— even death on a cross! (Philippians 2:8)
