



The Rules and Process

- 1 Think of a scene. Sketch some ideas. The theme for this year should be something about America for it's 250th birthday. It can represent a state, a historical moment, tourist attractions, etc. Biblical scenes are also acceptable! Please keep it family-friendly and non-controversial.
- 2 Make your diorama using a Peeps. They can be melted, molded and manipulated in order to make your masterpiece come to life. Size is up to you but no bigger than a refrigerator!
- 3 Limit one entry per person or one group entry. Yes, you can do one personal and one group entry.
- 4 Fill out an info form about your project and attach it to diorama. (Name/Family, Age, Contact, Name of Diorama, Description, Trash it or pick up, other helpers)
- 5 Drop off diorama on March 22-25th at the church offices. This is a family community event. If a diorama is potentially offensive or not family-friendly, we reserve the right to not display it. If you are uncertain about your diorama, contact us at office@gfchurch.net
- 6 Voting will happen **March 27-April 3rd**. Your entry will be posted on social media. People who like your entry on our social media account will get 1.5 votes towards their final count. Make sure that if you share, they vote on GFC's social media and not your personal post.
- 7 Winners will be announced April 5th during our Easter service. You are welcome to attend. Dioramas may be picked up following Easter service. If you don't want it back, please note for us to trash it on your entry form.
