## Read Matthew 21:23-32 Together

As Jesus brings his ministry to Jerusalem, his authority is questioned by the chief priests. In response, Jesus tells a parable about two sons: one who says the right thing, and one who does the right thing. What is God really looking for in his children?

## Discussion Questions

- 1. Why do you think the chief priests were more concerned with where Jesus derived his authority than whether or not what he was doing was right or wrong?
- 2. How does this parable paint the "tax collectors and prostitutes"? In what ways is this shocking? In what ways is this in line with the ministry of Jesus?
- 3. Why is it oftentimes easier to say the right thing than to do the right thing? How is this attitude reflected in our culture?
