DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- The video describes confession as a daily rhythm of Christian life rather than an occasional emergency response. Why do you think many Christians resist the idea of daily confession? How does the “greatest commandment” example challenge our understanding of sin and self-awareness?
- In light of Luke 9:23, how does thinking about discipleship as “daily death and resurrection” reshape the way we approach failure, repentance, and God’s mercy?
- The script says Christians lament “in hope, not despair,” because Jesus has conquered sin, the world, and the devil. How can Christians make space for honest sorrow, anger, and questions without losing hope? What does hopeful lament look like in practice?
