Big Idea

Christ commands us to repent, believe, and be baptized.

Our relationship with God is a "this or that" relationship. We are in a relationship with Jesus, or we are not. There is no middle ground. There is no, almost a Christian, or "I'm sort of a Christian." You either are a Christian, or you are not a Christian.

Repent – A Turning from this World To God

"The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has come near. **Repent** and believe the good news!" (**Mk** 1:15)

I have declared to both Jews and Greeks that they must turn to God in **repentance** and have **faith** in our Lord Jesus. (**Acts 20:21**)

Believe – A Trust and Allegiance In Christ

"Repent and **believe** the good news!" (**Mark 1:15**)

Since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. (Rom. 5:1)

Be Baptized – An Outward <u>Identification</u> with Christ

Jesus came from Nazareth in Galilee and was baptized (Mark 1:9)

"Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, **baptizing them** in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit" (**Matt 28:19**)

- It Is A Picture Of Our Cleansing From Sin
