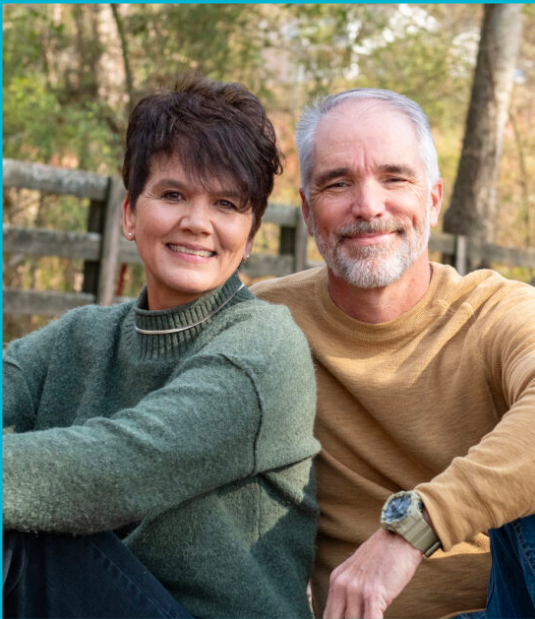
TAYLOR & GENNY - CLARKSTON, GEORGIA

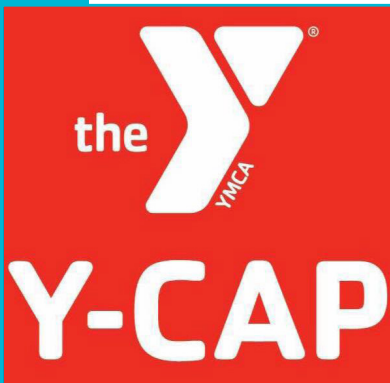
VOLUNTEERS IN MEDICINE
