SET UP

From the very beginning, God promised that He wouldn't stay distant. Through Isaiah, He declared that a Savior would come and be called Immanuel — “God with us.” That promise becomes real in John 1:14 when we're told that “the Word became flesh and dwelt among us.” Jesus didn't shout love from a distance; He stepped into our world, into our mess, into our story. Immanuel means God didn't just send help — He became our help. He came close so we could know Him, trust Him, and walk with Him.
