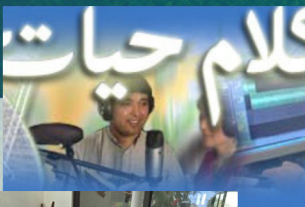
# CPC MISSION PARTNERS

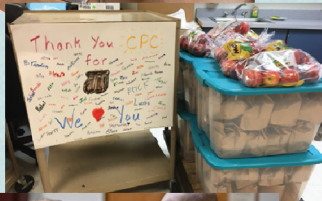

**The Lamb Center** is a daytime drop-in shelter for people experiencing homelessness in the Fairfax area. They provide breakfasts, lunches, showers, laundry services, Bible Studies, counseling, employment services, medical clinic and more.
