James and Faith Cha serve with the Crescent Project to mobilize the local church to share the gospel message with people of other religions and backgrounds, especially Muslim. They teach the Perspectives Missions class, ESL/GED classes, and multiple workshops to build relationships and to testify of the love and grace of Jesus Christ.



Philemon and Elisheba Chhetri pastor the New Life Mission in Nepal. NLM trains native missionaries to preach the gospel to all who have not yet heard. They have planted over 50 churches in remote areas of Nepal and Northeast India. The Chhetris also lead a flourishing media ministry to broadcast Christian programming throughout the region.



Marcia Montenegro leads Christian Answers for the New Age (CANA), a ministry responding to alternative religions, to inform and educate others about New Age and occult belief. As a former professional astrologer, Marcia was deeply involved in paranormal New Age practices. She understands the appeal and dangers of the paranormal and now teaches on these topics around the country, through podcasts, and online.



International Justice Mission strives to fulfill the Scriptures calling to “seek justice, rescue the oppressed, defend the orphan and plead for the widow” (Isaiah 1:17). IJM works to make justice systems function effectively for victims of abuse who urgently need the protection of the law. They bring rescue and restoration to victims of slavery, human trafficking, illegal home seizures, and other forms of violent oppression.



Western Fairfax Christian Ministry provides food and financial support to families at risk of hunger and homelessness. As an expression of God’s love and an opportunity to share the gospel of Jesus Christ, the WFCM staff helps families take steps toward health and sustainability. Corporate donors donate products, such as hygiene and household essentials, school and office supplies, health care and medical items, and building materials—all aimed at improving the quality of life for families battling poverty.
