The House family lives in southeast Asia, bringing education, providing relief, and sharing the gospel.

God's Garden offers the CPC family space to grow their own vegetables. Our community garden welcomes anyone interested in gardening and willing to give away a portion of their harvest to others. Join us to make a difference through gardening!

Life First is committed to seeking the best for those affected by an unplanned pregnancy. The Life First staff assists women to carry to term by providing Christ-centered emotional support and practical assistance. Through the provision of God's people and the community at large, women may face the future with hope, and plan constructively for themselves, their babies and families.

Paula Puckett serves with the InterVarsity Graduate & Faculty Ministries at the College of William & Mary in Williamsburg, Virginia. In 2021, she and her husband Blake launched Cambridge House, a Christian Study Center, for the university. Cambridge House engages the students, faculty, and staff of William & Mary by pursuing faith, intellectual integrity, and spiritual foundation through community.

Refugee Resettlement has become a tremendous need in our community. Our team walks alongside newly arriving families as they move and adjust to a new life. The ministry includes shopping for initial needs such as groceries and household goods, then continues as family members seek employment, register children for school, learn English, and more.

Sat-7 broadcasts Christian programming in Arabic (with indigenous Arab speakers and directors) into north Africa and the Middle East. While many of these countries are closed to the Gospel, their four satellite TV channels and online media, by-pass censorship. Viewers are coming to faith and Christians are growing in their faith.

Homestretch comes alongside families experiencing homelessness in Virginia, helping them to become independent by giving them the skills, knowledge and hope they need to become self-sufficient in the community. The Sacred Homes partnership allows our church to "adopt" a family and engage in hands-on acts of support and assistance.
