Review this week's message.

Key Scripture: Mark 12:41-44, Matthew 6:21

Start talking. Get the conversation rolling.

• If money wasn't a factor, what would you give your time, energy, or resources to right now?

Start sharing. Be open with your group.

- What stood out to you the most from this week's message?
- If you had to describe your relationship with money in one word, what would it be?
- How does our culture typically measure generosity, and how does that differ from the way Jesus measures it?
- Why do you think money has such a unique way of testing our trust in God?
- How does your generosity reflect what you truly trust in—money, security, or God?
- The message said, "We don't give to get—we give to get to give again." How can this mindset change the way you approach generosity?
- Think about this statement, "Generosity is measured by sacrifice, not amount." How does that challenge the way you think about your own giving?
- What's the difference between giving from your *surplus* vs. giving from your *sacrifice*? Which do you relate to more right now?

Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

Ask God to give you a widow's heart—one that trusts Him completely, even when it
costs something. Pray, "Lord, help me trust You more than I trust my money. Use what's
in my hand to accomplish what's in Your heart."

Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

Take time this week to pray and listen for what God is asking you to do in faith. Whether
it's tithing for the first time, giving above and beyond, or stepping out in another area of
obedience—write it down and commit to take that next step.
