Review this week's message.

Key Scripture: Nehemiah 2:17–20, Philippians 4:15–20

Start talking. Get the conversation rolling.

• When you were a kid, what's the biggest thing you ever tried to build (fort, Lego set, treehouse, etc.)?

Start sharing. Be open with your group.

- What stood out to you the most from this week's message?
- Nehemiah said "We are in trouble"... not "You." How does shared responsibility and shared calling change the way we see church, mission, and generosity?
- Vision invites resistance. Where have you recently felt pushback—spiritually, financially, emotionally—right after you stepped out in faith?
- Nehemiah looked at ruins and said, "We will rebuild." How easy or hard is it for you to say "yes" to something when you don't yet know the "how"?
- Nehemiah couldn't rebuild the wall alone, and Paul couldn't reach the nations alone. What does it look like for the church today to carry the vision *together*?
- How does thinking about generosity as an *investment in eternity*, rather than a loss, shift your perspective?
- Where do you personally see yourself in the Kingdom Builders framework right now? A builder? A sender? Both? Something else?

Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

 Pray boldly for one specific thing God is asking you to step into that feels "bigger than your resources.

Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

Identify one tangible step of obedience you can take to help fuel God's mission.
It could be a step of generosity, serving, sharing your faith, reconciliation or surrender.
Whatever it is, commit to do something this week that aligns your life with the vision God is calling you to help build.
